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

De-carbonization Works—Possible Changes to Dinner Menu

Works on the school site to improve our carbon foot print will begin during the summer holidays and may continue until October half term. We will be having solar panels installed on the roof and a new energy efficient heat source installed.



When the works start, all electricity must be turned off to enable rewiring and a consequence of this will be that our freezers will not be functional. In view of this and the need for using up any foods in the freezers, it may be necessary to change the school dinner menu on occasion so as to use all the food and prevent wastage.
